We ran a fascinating two-day symposium on the future of democracy, which, aside from the thought-provoking discussions, also became the first public forum at which an influential, Europe-wide report on sustainable equality was presented. We organised or participated in a number of lectures, exhibitions, and performances. We are steadily expanding our international network of alumni and friends. We are currently feverishly organising our second colloquium, which will be held on 8-13 December 2019 at the Alion Hotel, Ayia Napa, Cyprus.
